\* **+2 years extra (additional 2 years, over and above the normal re-admission period of 2 years, is granted to the students with disability as per Notification No.IG/SED/Ex.-III/ACD/PC/2015/541 dated October 6, 2015). Hence, two more years to be added in the schedule of TEE indicated in col. No. 9 above.**

Further, **EEC10 – National Income Accounting – 8 credits (Group 3) has been withdrawn from January 2016 session.** However, **term-end examination of the elective course (EEC-10) will be conducted up to June 2023.**

@ **EEC-19** has been withdrawn from January 2010 session.

**CIC-2 & CIC-5** was last offered to **B.Com students in Jan.2009 session.** Though CIC has been withdrawn as a stand alone programme, yet examination of both **CIC-2 & CIC-5** will be conducted up to **DEC.2016 TEE** exclusively for B.Com students.

**Note:**

1. Max. duration of 8 years plus the extended duration of 2 years on re-admission (8+2 = 10 years) remained valid upto Jan.2003 batch. Max. duration has been reduced to **6 years** effective from **July 2003** cycle of admission.
2. BDP admission was in January cycle only until it was **shifted to July cycle in the year 2003.** Therefore, admission was done in **two sessions in the year 2003 (Jan.2003 as well as July 2003).**
3. Subsequently, BDP admission remained in July cycle only till the introduction of **Walk-in Admission** in the year 2008. Thus, students were admitted in BDP in **both cycle of admissions from January 2009 session onwards.**
4. Admission to BPP was done through an **Entrance test** up to the **year 1991.** There was no TEE in BPP courses until then.
5. Initially, **PMT-01** (revised version OMT-101) was made compulsory. Subsequently it has been made optional effective from **Jan.2003.** Thus, a BPP student can choose any two courses, out of the three available, as of now.
6. On successful completion of BPP, they were promoted to BDP (non-formal stream). Initially it was B.A/B.Com only. **Max. duration of 8 years was accounted from the date of admission in to BPP itself.**
7. Allotment of separate Enrol.# for BPP students for their admission into B.A/B.Com etc. came in to force from **July 2004** session onwards. Thus, **max. duration of 6(six) years is accounted from the date of admission in to BDP even in case of non-formal stream students (i.e. through BPP) w.e.f. July 2004 session.**

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
